



3-Year-Old Class

The three-year-old program at St. Margaret's is led by Julie Voisard who has been a teaching aide at St. Margaret's preschool since 2003 and a preschool teacher since 2008. Her class focuses on children's developmental needs.

Requirements

For your child to be eligible for the three-year-old program he/she must turn three by Sept. 1 and be potty trained.

Class Times

Three-year-old classes are taught on Tuesdays and Thursdays. There are two class times available for children. Classes are from either 8:45-11:15 a.m. or 12:30-3 p.m.

All holiday and seasonal breaks coincide with St. Margaret's School. All weather related cancellations follow the school's policy as well.



Your child's imagination will soar while they're learning new skills that will ready them for the future.




Classroom Information

The children to adult ratio in each class is no more than 15 children to two adults.

Everyday your child will be served a healthy snack toward the end of their class period provided by a parent. The preschool teachers work hard to accommodate everyone's allergy needs and see to it that products containing food allergens are kept away from the classroom.

The preschool will have no more than 60 children total if all four classes are filled to maximum capacity.



4-Year-Old Class

The four-year-old program at St. Margaret's is led by Pam Porritt who has been teaching at St. Margaret's preschool since 2000 and has five years of experience in the public school system. Her class focuses on kindergarten readiness and academics.

Requirements

For your child to be eligible for the four-year-old program he/she must turn four by Dec. 1 and be potty trained.

Class Times

Four-year-old classes are taught on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays. There are two class times available for children. Classes are from either 8:45-11:15 a.m. or 12:30-3 p.m.

All holiday and seasonal breaks coincide with St. Margaret's School. All weather related cancellations follow the school's policy as well.
