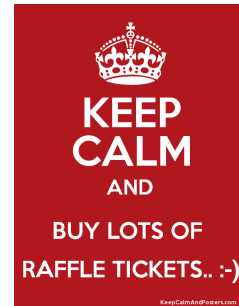
may be dropped off Friday 9:00 am-6:00 pm or Saturday before 11:00 am.
