COVID-19 SCHOOL PROTOCOLS

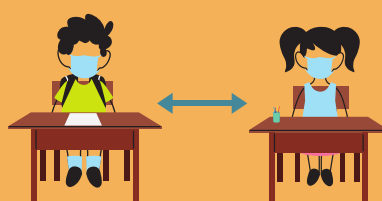
Below are protocols for the 2021-2022 school year. All protocols are based on Allegan County Health Department (ACHD) recommendations and requirements.

CLEANING



Tables and desks as well as commonly touched surfaces will be sanitized at least once a day.

DISTANCING



Student desks and tables will be spaced three feet apart whenever possible.

Students will eat lunch in the lunch room, maintaining social distancing.

HYGIENE

Staff will continue to encourage handwashing and good hygiene. Hand sanitizer will be available when handwashing is not possible.



MASKS

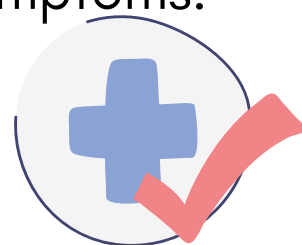


Face masks and coverings will not be required in school at this time. Each family will decide what is the best decision for their child. Masks are required when riding on school buses per CDC guidelines. ACHD strongly recommends face masks to be worn indoors by all individuals regardless of vaccination status.

HEALTH SCREENING

Parents are expected to screen their child every morning for COVID-19 symptoms. Attendance at school signals that your child has been screened and has no symptoms.
